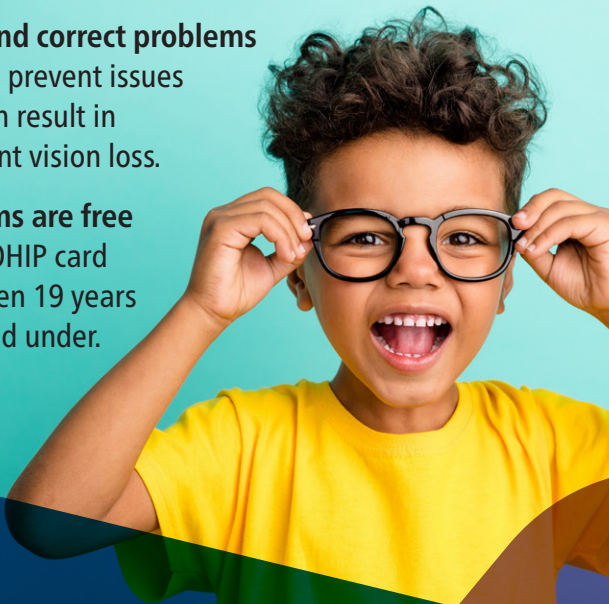


HAVE YOUR CHILD'S EYES CHECKED
