Dear Mr. Raynor:

For your information and records, at its regular meeting held on May 16, 2017 the Council of the Town of East Gwillimbury enacted as follows:



WHEREAS Town Council, in preparing its 2010 Official Plan, included a policy which stated "The Town shall work with the Region to decommission the Holland Landing Lagoon system for sewage treatment as an essential first phase of servicing for the Town"; and

WHEREAS Town Council provided a Resolution to the Region of York on May 3, 2016 requesting that the Holland Landing Lagoons be decommissioned once the 2nd Concession Sanitary Linear Works are commissioned; and

WHEREAS the 2nd Concession Sanitary Linear Works have been commissioned but the Holland Landing Lagoons have not yet been decommissioned; and

WHEREAS Town Council urges the Region to decommission the Lagoons as soon as possible with the flows being directed to the YDSS until the Water Reclamation Centre (WRC) is in place;

BE IT RESOLVED THAT once the Individual Environmental Assessment is approved, the Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change be requested to transfer the Environmental Compliance Approval for the Holland Landing Lagoons to the WRC and that the Region expeditiously decommission the Lagoons; and

THAT Council direct staff to forward a copy of this resolution to York Region and the MOECC.
