

THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF YORK

BYLAW NO. 2015-68

A bylaw to delegate to the Commissioner of Transportation Services the power to provide for reduced load periods on Regional Roads

WHEREAS section 122(7) of the *Highway Traffic Act* provides that a municipality having jurisdiction over a highway may by bylaw designate the date on which a reduced load period shall start or end and the highway or portion thereof to which the designation applies;

AND WHEREAS on November 19, 2015, Regional Council enacted Bylaw No. 2015-64 to consolidate the reduced load periods on Regional Roads;

AND WHEREAS section 23.1(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* authorizes a municipality to delegate its powers and duties under the *Municipal Act, 2001* or any other Act;

AND WHEREAS Regional Council wishes to delegate its authority under section 122 (7) of the *Highway Traffic Act*;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Regional Municipality of York hereby enacts as follows:

1. The Commissioner of Transportation Services for The Regional Municipality of York is hereby delegated the power to designate the date on which a reduced load period shall start or end and the highway or a portion of a highway to which the designation applies.
2. The Regional Clerk is hereby authorized to amend Schedules "A" and "B" to Bylaw No. 2015-64 in accordance with any designation authorized by the Commissioner.
